

**JULY 2013** 



During July 2013 Garuda Indonesia Group carried 2,022,774 passengers, representing an 11.3% growth year on year, while frequencies were up by 26%. The RPK (Revenue Passenger Kilometres) grew 5.7% against 13.5% growth in production capacity (Availabe Seat Kilometres/ ASK). As a result, the group seat load factor decreased by 5.5 percentage points to 74.4% since growth in traffic lagged by increasing capacity. We received one B737-800NG aircraft and one B777-300ER aircraft during July 2013.

#### **DOMESTIC PASSENGER SERVICES**

The number of passengers carried on our domestic service increased by 5.8% to 1,317,877 passengers. In July 2013, our domestic seat load factor declined by 8.9 percentage points to 76.7% as growth in capacity exceeded traffic growth. Domestic production capacity (ASK) recorded a 17.0% growth, while our domestic RPK increased by 4.9%. We added frequency on Makassar-Kendari route and also added two new routes i.e. Surabaya-Kupang and Medan-Pekanbaru. Starting on July 25, we moved from Polonia airport to Kuala Namu airport in Medan.

#### **INTERNATIONAL PASSENGER SERVICES**

We carried 328,762 passengers on international service, representing a 3.2% decrease year on year. Our international traffic (RPK) was down 1.4% from previous year's, while capacity (ASK) grew by 4.9%. As a result, international SLF decreased 4.6 percentage points to 71.7%. In international service, we added frequency on Denpasar-Singapore route, and added two new routes Denpasar-Brisbane and Surabaya-Singapore.

## **CITILINK**

Citilink's performance in this month maintained significant improvement in terms of passengers carried and production. The number of passengers carried was 376,135, representing a 62.3% growth year on year. The capacity (ASK) increased by 56.1% while RPK increased by 60.7%. This has sent the load factor improved to 78% or 2.3 percentage points higher than that of previous year. In July 2013, Citilink added new route Cengkareng to Pekanbaru.
