

INVESTOR UPDATE

PT Garuda Indonesia (Persero) Tbk.



Garuda Indonesia Group carried 1,902,903 passengers in April, denoted 20.0% growth year on year, and frequencies increased by 29.8%. The production capacity (measured in Availabe Seat Kilometres/ASK) grew by 17.3% while RPK's (Revenue passanger kilometres) was up by 13.2% over the same period the same year. As a results, the group seat load factor weakened by 2.62 percentage points to 72.39%. Aircraft utilization in April turn into 10:59 hours per day. We received another 1 (one) aircraft CRJ-1000, 1 (one) A330-200, and 1 (one) A320-200 during April 2013.

DOMESTIC PASSENGER SERVICES

In April 2013, RPK of domestic service recorded 6.2% growth, while production capacity (ASK) increase by 11.6%. This sent our seat load factor for Domestic services decline by 3.9 percentage points as the traffic demand did not fully match the capacity expansion. The number of passenger carried increased by 8.1% to 1,197,812 passenger. We add new routes in April from Medan to Batam, Palembang and Padang, also from Padang to Pekanbaru. This new routes corresponding to settle on Medan as our 2nd regional based for CRJ-1000.

INTERNATIONAL PASSENGER SERVICES

Our passenger on international service during April 2013 was up by 3.5% year on year to 302,435 passenger. Traffic demands for this month remain strong, as RPK increased by 6.1% on 5.5% more capacity (ASK). Consequently, seat load factor slightly increased by 0.4 percentage points to 72.3% year on year.

CITILINK

Continuing previous months growth, this April Citilink keep record outstanding performance. The passenger numbers achieved 402,656, recorded 117.6% growth year on year. RPK extensively increased by 115.3% compared to April previous year, and capacity (ASK) was up by 136.7%. This had sent SLF decreased by 6.2 percentage points as capacity expansion outstripped growth in RPK. During April 2013, Citilink add new routes & destinations such as: Jakarta to Bengkulu, Jambi, Semarang, Pangkal Pinang, Tanjung Karang, Jogjakarta, Malang; and from Makassar to Jogjakarta.
