

# **INVESTOR UPDATE**

PT Garuda Indonesia (Persero) Tbk.



Garuda Indonesia Group posted another outstanding monthly result in February with number of passengers carried reached 1,813,874 passengers or 25.21% more than previous year. This achievements was in line with our production capacity (Availabe Seat Kilometres /ASK) which grew by 14.85%, whereas demands (Revenue passenger kilometres/RPK) increased 25.88%. The group load factor increase by 6.8 percentage points to 77.61%, while frequencies were up 21.17% year-on-year. During February 2013, our aircraft utilization reached 11:15 hours per day, recorded 26 minutes better than previous year.

#### **DOMESTIC PASSENGER SERVICES**

On our domestic service, we carried 1,150,743 passengers during the month of February, 13.59% more than previous year. Demands on February this year were considerably strong, as RPK grew higher than ASK. Domestic demands (RPK) expanded by 11.74%, whereas capacity (ASK) only expanded 10.80%. Our domestic load factor increase by 0.6 percentage points to 79.0%. We have performed well in domestic passenger service even if the month of February considered as the low season.



#### **INTERNATIONAL PASSENGER SERVICES**

During the month of February 2013, we carried 287,880 passenger on international service, or 12.76% higher than previous year. Similar to domestic service demands, on February our international service demands (RPK) grew by 27.06%, significantly higher than growth of capacity (ASK) were increase by 8.91% from previous year. This has sent our international passenger services SLF increase by 10.86 percentage points to 76.06% year on year.



### **CITILINK**

Continuing previous months growth, this month Citilink carry on outstanding performance. The passenger carried achieved 375,251 passengers, or 108.1% more than previous year. The demand (RPK) extensively grew by 106.3%, higher than the growth of capacity (ASK) which is 77.06% year on year. This fast growth has sent the load factor increase to 79.10% or 11.17 percentage points higher than previous year. On February 28, Citilink received its 15th aircraft A320-200, which brings to a total fleets of 22 aircraft at the end of February 2013.
