

APRIL 2015



Garuda Indonesia group carried 2,167,933 passenger during April 2015, or 26.59% higher compare to the previous year. This improvement result impacted by the increasing of demands (RPK) which grew 21.85% while the ASK grew 8.42% compare to the previous year. The group load factor increase by 8.1 percentage points to 73.6%, while frequencies were up 18.63% year-on-year. During April 2015, the aircraft utilization recorded 09:18 hours per day, about 41 minutes shorter than the same month previous year. In this month, we took delivery of our 9th ATR72-600 aircraft, which sent the group total fleets in operation to 175 fleets. The avarage age of fleet could be managed become 5.36 years in this period.

CITILINK

Citilink's performance in April 2015 has successfully maintained significant improvement, in terms of passenger carried, demand & production. Number passenger increased 38.44% from previous year to 716,370, The demands (RPK) were up by 41.76%, while recorded capacity (ASK) increase by 26.75% compare previous year. The load factor increased 8.6 basis point to 81.1% compare previous year result. In April 2015, Garuda and Citilink have successfully to keep going better operational performance.

DOMESTIC PASSENGER SERVICES

In domestic service, Garuda carried 1,557,859 passengers during the month of April, reached 24.90% more than previous year. The demand in April 2015 remaining strong compare previous month, as RPK expanded by 27.78%, while the capacity (ASK) grew by 19.55%. The domestic load factor also improve by 4.7 percentage points to 73.5%.

INTERNATIONAL PASSENGER SERVICES

In international service, Garuda carried 343,704 passengers, or 13.33% higher compare previous year result. The International demands (RPK) were up by 9.87%, while recorded capacity (ASK) slightly decrease by 5.62%. The lower production in international services is a continuation from quick wins programs held by the company, reduce unprofitable international routes. Our international load factor increase 10 percentage points, to 71% compare previous year
