APRIL 2021: PASSENGER INCREASES BY 390.63% YOY AND CARGO INCREASES BY102.37% YOY

Garuda Indonesia Group carried 1.08M passengers in April 2021, or increased by 390.63% YoY compares to April 2020. Comparing to pre COVID-2019, it reached 45.11% passengers in April 2019. These passengers were served with capacity (ASK) 2.62 billion, or significant increased by 136.91% YoY compares to ASK previous year. Comparing to pre COVID-2019, it reached 51.61% ASK in April 2019.

In Addition, number of cargo was 28.68K ton or increased by 102.37% YoY compares to cargo carried last year. Comparing to pre COVID-2019, it reached 93.70% cargo in April 2019. These cargoes were served with cargo capacity (ATK Cargo) 98.81 million, or increased by 155.26% YoY compares to ATK Cargo last year. Aligning with the increasing capacity, aircraft utilization also improved 5:28 hours from 01:12 hours last year to be 06:40 hours in April 2021.

From financial perspectives, the Group's cost structure is continuously managed efficiently as the unit cost of CASK and CASK Ex Fuel decreased by -42.92% YoY and -49.88% in consecutive. Fuel price also decreased by -12.75% YoY from USc57.39 to be Usc 50.07 this month. Furthermore, passenger yield increased by 13.48% YoY and cargo yield increased by 3.03% YoY.

SUPPORT THE ACCELERATED DISASTER MANAGEMENT, GARUDA INDONESIA OPERATES THE HUMANITARIAN FLIGHT TO SEVERAL AFFECTED AREA IN NTT

Jakarta, April 8th 2021 - The national airline PT Garuda Indonesia Tbk. operates humanitarian flights to transport humanitarian aid to people affected by flash floods in a number of areas of East Nusa Tenggara (NTT) on April 7th 2021. This humanitarian flight flew from Makassar at 04.30 WITA and arrived in Kupang at 07.00 WITA by using the type of aircraft ATR 72-600. The flight has carried aid items for every flood victims such as food supplies, medicines, and clothes that has been supported by several of Indonesian State Owned Enterprises and volunteers.
