JUNE 2021: POST 'EID HOMECOMING BAN POLICY', PASSENGER INCREASED BY 41.97% MOM

Garuda Indonesia Group (The Group) served 1,20 million passengers in June 2021, or increased by 41.97% MoM or increased by 451.60% YoY and reached 41.90% number of passenger pre COVID-19. The number of passenger recovered significantly post Eid homecoming ban policy. Adjusting demand recovery, The Group added the ASK capacity by 22.34% MoM, or increased by 149.67% YoY and reached 48.76% ASK pre COVID-19.

In Addition, The Group added the ATK capacity by 9.78% MoM, or increased by 141.02% YoY and reached 39.95% ATK pre COVID-19. With this ATK capacity, The Group carried 23.02K ton cargo or slightly decreased 1.12% MoM, or increased by 59.85% YoY and reached 98.34% number of cargo pre COVID-19.

GARUDA INDONESIA SUPPORTS TRANSPORTATION OF 1500 OXYGEN CONCENTRATORS FROM SHANGHAI TO JAKARTA

JAKARTA - July 14th 2021 Garuda Indonesia supports the transportation of medical supplies in the form of 1500 oxygen concentrator units from the Singapore Temasek Foundation in collaboration with 15 Indonesian and Singaporean companies as a form of support for efforts to handle the COVID-19 pandemic in Indonesia.
